WHAT WE ACCEPT

People transitioning from homelessness often have very little other than their clothes. Although we attempt to provide them with choices of basic items, we can only accept furniture that will fit in a small apartment and can be moved upstairs without an elevator. In order to treat our clients with dignity and respect, we cannot accept items that are stained, torn, damaged by pets, chipped, or broken. Disposing of damaged or unsuitable items comes at a cost to New Life that takes away from our ability to serve clients. We do not have the resources to repair, paint, or refinish furniture.

As a rule of thumb, if you would not give it to a family member or friend, it is not suitable for a client. We will inspect items before accepting and reserve the right to refuse anything not appropriate for our clients.
