## HOUSEWARMING BASKETS

New Life Furniture Bank of MA collects gently-used furniture and household goods to be provided to individuals and families transitioning out of homelessness at no cost.

A bed to sleep on, a table to eat at, and a pan to cook in help provide stability for our clients, but living in an apartment still comes at a significant cost. The first trip to the store to buy basic household essentials, such as cleaning supplies and toilet paper, can be very expensive for those with little or nothing to begin. A laundry basket filled with practical everyday living items reduces the financial burden of getting started in a new apartment and helps those transitioning from homelessness find stability.

Housewarming baskets are a great option for anyone looking to arrange a remote service activity or involve volunteers under the age of fourteen.
